The Arts Picnic Fine Art Exhibit provides Weld County artists the opportunity to display their creations for family, friends and for the community to enjoy. The City of Greeley is proud of the magnitude of talented artists residing in Weld County. As a sponsor of our community art exhibit, The Arts Picnic strives to promote and encourage the arts while improving the quality of life in Greeley.

ABOUT TOINTON GALLERY

The Tointon Gallery, 651 10th Avenue, presents twelve changing art exhibits each year to the community. Artwork is displayed with a wide variety of media, artist styles and skill levels to provide enjoyment, education and to encourage dialogue about art. The gallery can be accessed through the first floor lobby of the Greeley Recreation Center and is open Monday through Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Admission is free.

ELIGIBILITY

Open to all artists residing in Weld County. Artwork must have been produced in the last two years and not previously shown in the Tointon Gallery.

EXHIBIT

In order to allow ample space for each work of art entered, we will accept ONLY the first 100 applications in the Adult division. To maintain variety in the overall exhibit we may limit applications for any one media to 25% of the total number of pieces in the show. The number of student applications accepted will not be limited.

- All forms of fine art are eligible for display.
- Limit one piece per artist.
- The gallery will not collect a commission.
- There is no entry fee.
- All artwork must be delivered on time.
- Work must stay on display until show closes.
- All art will be displayed at the discretion of the Tointon Gallery Visual Arts Committee.

ANNUAL ARTS PICNIC FINE ART EXHIBIT

Adult 2-D work must be properly framed and ready to hang by a wire. Maximum size for 2-D work is 150 inches. To determine total inches, measure all four sides of the frame and add the numbers together.

Student 2-D work may be matted, mounted, and/or framed and must be ready to hang.

All 3-D work must be ready for display.

LIABILITY

Works will only be insured while they are on the premises and only from July 22, 2019- September 2, 2019. Artwork is not required to be for sale, but the insurance value is required. Claim reimbursement is subject to verifiable value.

OPENING ARTIST RECEPTION

The Arts Picnic Fine Art Exhibit Reception will be held on Friday, July 26 from 5-7 p.m. in the Tointon Gallery. Come visit with artists and enjoy some light refreshments.

ARTS PICNIC KICK-OFF CONCERT

The Arts Picnic Kick-Off Concert will follow the reception beginning at 7 p.m. on the 9th Street Plaza. The concert is presented by The City of Greeley and co-sponsored by the Downtown Development Authority and Sears Real Estate.

PARTICIPATION IN THE FINE ARTS EXHIBIT IS AN AGREEMENT ON THE PART OF THE ARTIST TO THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH ABOVE.

Applications will be marked according to the date we receive them. The first 100 adult division, (and all student division) applicants will be eligible to enter artwork. You will only be notified if your work is not accepted because of limited space.

**The Charging Bull of Wall Street**

The Charging Bull statue near Wall Street was created by sculptor Arturo Di Modica who paid the product cost of US\$350,000 out of his own pocket.

The statue weighs 7,000 pound (3,175 kg). The statue was placed on a New York City street in 1987 without city permits, but was eventually moved to the Financial District, just steps away from Wall Street.

People believe that by touching the Bull, and taking selfies with the Bull will increase their chances of good fortune.
